




# Year 4

## English:

- In the first half term, we will be reading poems by John Lyon
- We will also be reading *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes. We will be writing a first person reflection, a character description and some poetry.
- In the second half term we will be reading *Harry Potter and the Philosopher's stone* by J.K Rowling.

Children will continue to read weekly as part of our Shared reading sessions. It would be great if you could ask your child what they have been learning about in reading and their English lessons to reinforce the learning that takes place.

Within Writing sessions, children will be demonstrating their understanding of writing at a Year 4 level and therefore it is important that they are here for all sessions so as to build their understanding of what makes a successful writer.

Remember to read at least 5 times a week and to fill in your Reading Record in the Learning Links!  
Also, practise your spellings every day so that you become a super speller!



## Mathematics

This term pupils will be focusing on:

- Multiplication and Division
- Area and Perimeter
- Fractions
- Decimals

Every morning, we complete some arithmetic practice as part of our daily calculations. Please make sure your child is in at 8.40am every day.

**Remember to practise your times tables daily! All year 4 children will have a times table test at the end of year 4. Children MUST know all their times tables up to 12x12 by the end of Year 4.**

## Personal, Health, Social and Community Education (P.H.S.C.E.)

We will be starting the topic 'Financial Understanding'. This unit looks at ways to gain money and how to manage money effectively.

In the second half term, we will look at 'Family and Friends'. This unit looks at respecting others, keeping friends and resolving conflicts.

## Topic — Amazing Art ( First half term)
