School Dinners

Our daily menu will be available to view on Bromcom so please make sure you have registered for this. All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to free school dinners as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals. This will save parents £10 per week if your child has lunches at school. This also applies for families who receive pupil premium funding. **Children in Year 3 will need to pay for school dinners.**

Online Safety

Being safe online means individuals are protecting themselves and others from online harms and risks which may jeopardise their personal information, lead to unsafe communications or even effect their mental health and wellbeing.

Operating within an online space is something most of us simply do without thinking, but have you ever stopped to consider the potential dangers which exist on the web, especially for our children?

The recent Ofcom 'Children and Parents: media use and attitudes report 2019' found that children are more engaged online than they've ever been. Ownership of smart devices is increasing and the range of content they are viewing is expanding.

In an ever-changing world, ensuring children's safety online has never been more important. It's something that everyone must be aware of and watch out for.
