On Wednesday 27th September, TMET's Executive Team visited Abbey Mead Academy. TMET is the educational trust that looks after Abbey Mead and 12 other Mead schools in Leicester and Leicestershire. The TMET Executive Team visit every Mead school so that we can witness, first hand, the wonderful work that takes place at each of our schools.

During the visit, we had the pleasure of talking to children in lessons and at lunchtime, visiting classrooms, talking with staff and meeting with parents. We were very impressed with what we saw during our visit. There was a strong culture and sense of belonging across the school.

The children's behaviour was remarkable; they were confident, kind, fun and demonstrated a real love of learning. We observed an exceptionally high quality of work, including exemplary presentation, and admired the children's attitudes to learning.

Throughout the visit, it was clear that staff are passionate and dedicated to do the best for pupils. It was a joy to witness their commitment to fostering positive and impactful relationships with the community.

We could also sense the school's commitment to providing an inclusive learning experience. We met with a group of parents, who expressed gratitude to the school for its SEND provision, commenting upon the school's ability to make their children 'feel at home'.

We understood that funding for educational visits and trips was limited and have agreed with Mr Aldred to provide additional funding to ensure the school is able to continue providing these valuable experiences.

Online Safety

Talk about personal information:

Help your child to understand what's meant by personal information, so they can develop an awareness of why it's significant and why they should be cautious about sharing pictures of themselves or information online.

Some things for your child to know:

- What you put online stays online. Even things you delete can be saved or screenshotted including those Snapchats meant for just one friend.
- Online strangers are still strangers. Forums and group chats can be a great way to connect over things you wouldn't say face to face, but don't feel pressured to share more than you feel comfortable with.
- It's easy to over-share on social media, especially if you forget who can see your profile.
- Privacy is possible. You can change your settings to make your account private so that only people you know, and trust can see your updates.

Don't hesitate to block anyone who makes you feel uncomfortable and talk to someone you trust about it if this happens.
