## Online Safety

### What are age ratings?

Age ratings ensure that entertainment content – such as films, DVDs, and games – is clearly labelled for the minimum age group for which it is suitable. Age ratings help you decide whether to buy a particular product.

Since 2012, PEGI is the only system used in the UK for new computer games. In the UK, PEGI 12, 16 and 18 ratings are legally enforceable, meaning that they cannot be supplied to persons below those ages.

The PEGI rating on a game shows that it contains content suitable for a certain age group and above. So, a 7-rated game is suitable for everyone who is seven or older, while an 18-rated game is deemed suitable for adults only. It does not show who will enjoy the game or how difficult it is. When buying a game for anyone under the age of 18, always look at the age rating to check it is suitable for the intended user. Adult games contain adult only content, so you should treat them just like any other 18-rated medium. You will also find content descriptors on games which tell you what the game includes, so you can decide whether you want to play a game containing that content or not.
