Online Safety

TikTok is a video-sharing platform where you can watch and create videos, and livestream. The app has an age-rating of 13+. Anyone with an account can upload a video to the platform. This means that there's a whole range of videos that feature different topics, challenges, or ideas.

Some might include:

dancing or lip-synching clips from TV shows or films sports comedy sketches or funny videos recipes fitness TikTok

news or world events.

TikTok can be a creative outlet for young people as it allows them to learn about video editing and discover new interests. However, it can be easy for children and young people to come across inappropriate content on the app. The app also has chat features that allow users to privately message each other which could put your child at risk of being contacted by someone they don't know.

If you know that your child has a TikTok account, it may be worth setting up family pairing. This allows you to connect your child's account with your own. It gives you access to parental controls to help manage who they can speak to and how long they can spend on the app.

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
