or scan the QR code using your smartphone camera to go straight to the website.



At Abbey Mead, we aim to provide a stimulating and challenging learning environment where all pupils can attain their full potential. In order to do this we ask that you provide some feedback on our wraparound care facilities.

Currently, we offer Breakfast Club to all pupils at Abbey Mead. This runs from 7.30am to 8.30 am every day during term time. The cost of this is just £1 per session and this can be booked as and when it is required. We also offer and after school care option every day during term time. The cost for this is £2 per session and this can also be booked when required.
