Pupil Premium

Here at Abbey Mead our aim is to support children in their well-being and encourage a positive outlook. This involves ensuring all pupils receive the support and individualised provision they require to achieve their potential. Pupils and families are also supported in overcoming barriers which prevent children from learning.



We have launched a new initiative to support families who receive pupil premi-

um. Every week, children in Key Stage 2 who are on pupil premium (Free School Meals) will receive a ticket which they can redeem for a free fruit at the snack shack on their allocated day. This scheme will begin after the half term holiday and will continue for the rest of this academic year.

Also, all children who are eligible for Pupil Premium will be entitled to come to our very popular Breakfast club completely free of charge from 28th October 2024. This runs every day from 7.30 am in the lower hall.

In addition to this, over the coming weeks, each child who receives pupil premium will also be given a 'Golden Ticket' which will allow the child to take part in a 6 week club of their choice. Keep a look out for the tickets!

Who is eligible for benefits-related free school meals?

- Income support
- Income-based jobseeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child tax credit (provided you're not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- The guarantee element of state pension credit
- Working tax credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credit.

What is pupil premium?

Pupil premium is extra funding the government gives to schools to raise the achievement of disadvantaged pupils. If you feel that your child may be eligible for pupil premium, please speak to a member of the office team.

Parents are encouraged to register their children, this is to raise extra money for the school, which can be used towards extra tuition, teaching assistants and after school clubs.
