We are inviting children and staff to come to school dressed up as TT Rockstars Avatars next Tuesday. It will help promote the importance of times tables in school.

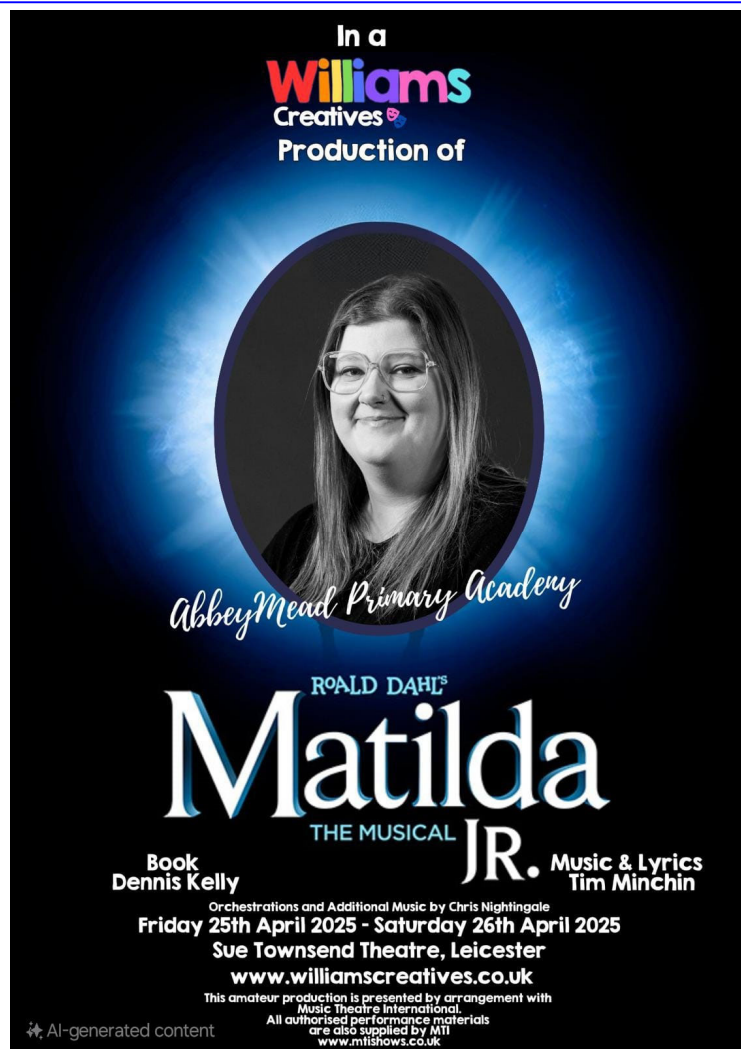

Each child that registers with Cool Milk will receive a 189ml portion of semi-skimmed milk every day, delivered fresh and chilled to the classroom. Their school milk will not only provide them with essential nutrients, but as it is rehydrating and energy boosting it also bridges the gap between breakfast and lunch to help children stay focused.

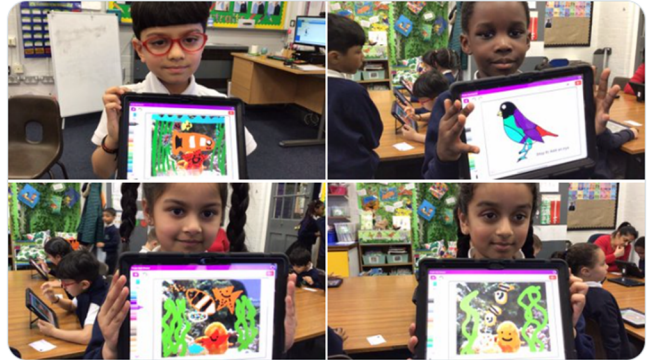
