## Important Update Regarding School Meal Costs

We are committed to providing all our children with freshly prepared, nutritious meals each day. These meals play an important role in supporting pupils' learning, wellbeing and overall development.

As you may be aware, the cost of food and supplies has continued to rise nationally. While we have worked hard across the Trust to minimise the impact of these increases on families, we do now need to make a small adjustment to the cost of school meals.

From **28th August 2025**, the price of a primary school meal for pupils in **Years 3, 4, 5 and 6** who choose to have a school meal will increase slightly, from **£2.00 to £2.05 per day**. This equates to a small increase of 5p per day.

Please be assured that this decision has not been made lightly, and we will continue to keep prices under review. We remain committed to keeping costs as low as possible for families; while ensuring we can maintain the quality and freshness of the meals we provide.

Children in **Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** will continue to receive free school meals under the government's Universal Free School Meal scheme.



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## Nursery

We are pleased to say that we are taking registration for our nursery for September 2025 so please contact the school and register your children if they are eligible. We are also offering 30 hour places for children who are eligible. Both parents need be in employment to qualify for the 30 hour option.

We have already filled 67 places through word of mouth and through siblings; this is bril-

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
