Sun Screen

It is important that all children apply sun screen in the summer to protect from sun burn and skin damage. Children's skin is highly sensitive and can easily burn when exposed to the sun. Sun screen will protect the skin and keep it hydrated and healthy whilst the children enjoy the sunshine and the fresh air.

We encourage children to bring sun cream to school during the hot weather to apply when we take children outdoors.

Please make sure your child is able to apply sun cream independently whilst in school. Teachers can remind children to apply sun cream before going outdoors but they should be able to apply the cream themselves. Sun screen can be bought from any supermarket or pharmacy and is not very expensive.

Remember to send sun cream, sun hats and plenty of water with your child every day during summer.
